

**MIDDLE PAXTON TOWNSHIP, DAUPHIN COUNTY
PUBLIC NOTICE**

The Board of Supervisors of the Township of Middle Paxton, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania will hold a public meeting on May 4, 2026, at 7:00 p.m. at the Middle Paxton Township Municipal Building, 10 Elizabeth Avenue, Dauphin, PA 17018, at which the Board of Supervisors will consider the enactment of an ordinance establishing regulations for solicitation and peddling in the Township. The title and summary of the proposed ordinances are as follows:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MIDDLE PAXTON, DAUPHIN
COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ADOPTING REGULATIONS AND
STANDARDS APPLICABLE TO SOLICITING AND PEDDLING GOODS IN
THE TOWNSHIP.

Section 1 enacts Chapter 200 regulating peddling and solicitation in the Township. Section 2 provides that all other sections of the Middle Paxton Township Ordinances not modified by the Amendment remain in full force and effect. Section 3 is a severability clause and Section 4 provides for the enactment of the Ordinance.

The full text of the proposed amendatory ordinances is on file for inspection and review without charge (or a copy may be obtained for a charge not greater than the cost thereof) at the Middle Paxton Township Municipal Building and the newspaper publishing this notice.
