**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF
MIDDLE PAXTON TOWNSHIP, DAUPHIN COUNTY ADOPTING CERTAIN FEES**

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors have adopted Ordinance No. 2026-1, establishing Chapter 200, regulations on peddling and soliciting in the Township; and

WHEREAS, the provisions thereof authorize the Township to charge a fee for application to the Township for a registration certificate to peddle or solicit within the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Township is entitled to charge a fee for its costs associated with the promulgation of a process for application, the review of the applications, issuance of the registration, monitoring of compliance, and enforcement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of Middle Paxton Township hereby adopts the fee of \$[XX.00] as the application fee to be charged when a person applies for registration as a peddler or solicitor in the Township.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this policy shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
