

**MIDDLE PAXTON TOWNSHIP, DAUPHIN COUNTY
PUBLIC NOTICE**

The Board of Supervisors of the Township of Middle Paxton, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania will hold a public hearing on July 9, 2026, at 7:00 p.m. at the Middle Paxton Township Municipal Building, 10 Elizabeth Avenue, Dauphin, PA 17018, at which the Board of Supervisors will take public comment on, and after which, consider the enactment of an ordinance amendment permitting mini storage warehouses in the mixed use zoning district. The title and summary of the proposed ordinances are as follows:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE MIDDLE PAXTON
TOWNSHIP ZONING ORDINANCE OF 2000, AS AMENDED,
PERMITTING MINI STORAGE WAREHOUSES IN THE MX –
MIXED USE DISTRICT AND PROVIDING FOR CERTAIN
SUPPLEMENTAL REGULATIONS FOR SUCH USE.

Section amends the Middle Paxton Township Zoning Ordinance of 2000, Article B, Mixed Use District, Section 802, Use and Lot Requirements, Table 8, MX-Mixed Use District, by inserting mini-storage warehouses as the new line 25 to allow mini-storage warehouses in the MX District by special exception. Section 2 amends the Middle Paxton Township Zoning Ordinance of 2000, Article 13, Supplemental Regulations, by adding new Section 1328, Mini-Storage Warehouses, to provide regulations for the use. Section 3 provides that all other sections of the Middle Paxton Township Ordinances not modified by the Amendment remain in full force and effect. Section 4 is a severability clause and Section 5 provides for the enactment of the Ordinance.

The full text of the proposed amendatory ordinances is on file for inspection and review without charge (or a copy may be obtained for a charge not greater than the cost thereof) at the Middle Paxton Township Municipal Building. Copies of the proposed Amendments are also available at the newspaper publishing this notice.
